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His research focuses on mathematics education, dynamic geometry, automated reasoning, and educational software development. Dr. Kovács has made significant contributions to open-source and academic projects, maintaining repositories on GitHub and other open-source resources.

He has organized and chaired international conferences, including the 2021 ADG conference, and actively collaborates in the fields of computer algebra and theorem proving. His work has earned multiple awards, notably the Distinguished Software Demonstration Award at ISSAC 2024 and 2016.
